



Qustodio Wins El Mundo ZEN Adecco Award for Best Entrepreneurial Project

Madrid, 4 December, 2019–Qustodio, the leading platform for cyber safety and digital wellbeing for families, has won the 2nd Prize for the Best Entrepreneur Project in the IV edition of the EL MUNDO Zen Adecco Awards for helping children use the internet and screentime responsibly.



The aim of these awards, presented yesterday at the *Espacio CÓMO* in Madrid, is to recognize the best companies and initiatives in seven different categories: Best Solidarity Project, Best Entrepreneurial Project, Best Creative and Innovative Spaces, Best Promotion of Physical Activity and Healthy Habits, Best Attraction, Generation and Maintenance of Talent, Most ZEN Manager and Best Flextime and Balance Policies.

A total of 21 companies and initiatives were chosen from the more than 165 entries from 120 companies. All were evaluated by a professional jury including Iker Barricat, general director of Adecco Spain; Dr. Antonio Ríos, Traumatologist; Jesús Cubero, director of Marketing and Communications at Adecco Spain; Father Angel, President of Messengers of Peace; Carina Spitzka, founder of K Fund VC and president of Adigital; president, Juan Fornieles, deputy director of El Mundo, Iván Martínez-Cubells, director of

the Cross-sectional Lifestyle Area of *Unidad Editorial*; and Enrique Sánchez, president of the Adecco Group in Southern Europe.

The Qustodio parental control platform, created in 2012 in Barcelona, has more than **2 million users** worldwide distributed across 195 countries. *"We are very proud of this award that shows us that we are on the right track and encourages us to continue fighting to help more and more families to improve their safety and wellbeing in the digital environment,"* says **Manuel Bruscas**, vice president of product in **Qustodio**.
